


In January 2018, Oxygen Forensics and Project VIC partnered to help fight children exploitation. Forensic experts can now search child abuse content in mobile and cloud extractions by hash sets taken from the Project VIC library. They can also export information on the extraction to the JSON file compatible with Project VIC.

To make use of this functionality, an expert should have a fully-featured license of Oxygen Forensic® Detective and an access to the Project VIC library with hash sets. Once Oxygen Forensic® Detective extracts data from a mobile device or a cloud account, an investigator can go to Search section, upload Project VIC hash sets, and click the Search Files button. Any images found to be suspicious will be copied to the Project VIC section in Oxygen Forensic® Detective and classified in accordance with the Project VIC Classification Standard. Forensic experts can generate a court-proven report with the identified child abuse content to any of the supported formats: PDF, RTF, XLS, XML, etc.

By downloading files from Project VIC extensive library of hash signatures, forensic experts collaborate with the rest of the world on identifying if they have illegal content or images of interest to the Global VIC Community.
